- Volunteer Sign-In/ Sign-Out
- Setting up functions and leaders as the actual need arises
- Radio Message Relays
- Light Search and Rescue
- Triage for Medical Treatment
- Lunch by the Salvation Army
- Exercise Debriefing

Location: **Brookview Park**, 1201 Monument Blvd, closest cross street is Mohr Lane, next to the creek that separates Concord from Pleasant Hill.
